The Top 4 Health Areas and 15 Top Issues that were identified by Stone County residents were determined via Individual surveys at many local events between October 2021 and August 2022.



QUALITY-OF-LIFE

From a survey of 8 questions, participants in Stone County identified economic opportunity as their greatest concern.

- Overall Quality of Life: 4.3/5
- Healthcare System: 3.6/5
- Raising Children: 4.1/5
- Growing Old: 4.3/5
- Economic Opportunity: 3.1/5
- Safe Place to Live: 4.3/5
- Networks of Support: 3.9/5
- Contribution Opportunities: 3.8/5

In a Forces of Change Assessment, the coalition determined the 4 Major Threats and Opportunities to Stone County, MO to be:
